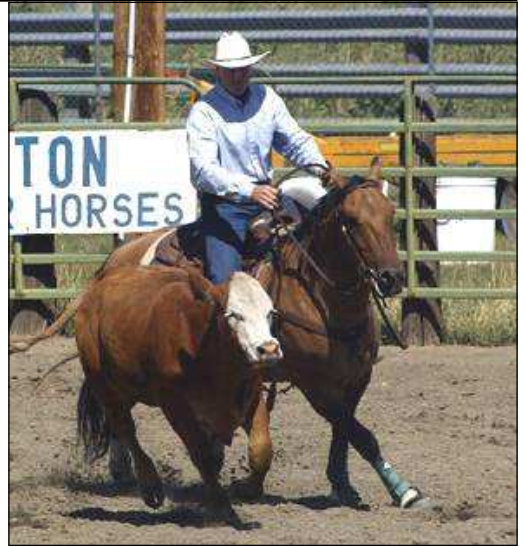

How to read cattle flight zones for correct rider positioning for control while herding, sorting, turning, driving and roping.

Team skills to work together with 2-3 other riders to control herd movement and rider positioning for roping, sorting, or penning, with the least amount of stress on the cattle and horses.

How to handle cattle on the ground once they are roped, for doctoring or branding.

All techniques are applicable to real ranch working situations from moving and sorting cattle to pasture doctoring and branding and may help insure you will be a welcome addition on your next cattle move.



Fundamental horsemanship skills required for **controlling challenging situations with confidence**. Learn to use the horse's **natural curiosity and draw** to replace fear with confidence and courage.

Gate opening made simple, navigating **deep narrow ditches** with "buggers", introduction to **water & diverse terrain**, high narrow bridges, ground tying, **backing ditches**, and more. Obstacle type depends on location.
